

**KINGS GRANT OPEN SPACE ASSOCIATION**  
**SWIMMING POOL FACILITIES RULES AND REGULATIONS – 2023 SEASON**  
**AS OF May 25, 2023**

1. The Kings Grant Open Space Association (“KGOSA”) swimming pool facilities are open:
  - Weekends only - Saturday, May 27, 2023, through Sunday, June 25, 2023.
  - Open daily beginning Monday, June 26, 2023, through Monday, September 4, 2023.
  - Pool Hours are 11:00 AM – 8:00 PM; the pool will be closed for 30 minutes every afternoon.

*THIS SCHEDULE IS SUBJECT TO CHANGE WITHOUT NOTICE.*

2. No one is permitted in the pool area unless a lifeguard is on duty.
3. All persons are to leave the pool property promptly at closing time.
4. The pool manager or the designated person in charge has the authority to close the pool at any time if, in his/her opinion, it is necessary for the safety or well being of the members, due to inclement weather or other appropriate reasons. The pool must be vacated immediately upon direction of the lifeguard.
5. Admittance to the pool on any given time or day is controlled by the bather load regulations set by the Burlington County Health Department. The bather load for the Kings Grant Swim Pool complex has been set at 400 persons at any given time. Therefore, admittance will be based on the bather load on a first-come, first-served basis.

**MEMBER OBLIGATIONS**

1. No one will be permitted in the pool area without a membership identification card (“ID card”).
2. Lost ID cards may be replaced at a cost of \$5 per card.
3. Transfer or loan of ID cards is prohibited and will result in termination of pool membership.
4. KGOSA is not responsible for the loss, for any reason, of clothing, jewelry, valuables, or any personal property. Please leave your valuables at home.
5. Please handle pool furniture with care. The cost of any property damage will be charged to the responsible person(s).
6. Tables and umbrellas are provided by KGOSA. Saving or holding of tables or umbrellas for others is not permitted.
7. All children 14 years and under must be accompanied in the pool area by an adult or responsible minor at least 16 years old. A responsible minor who is 16 or 17 years of age shall not have more than three children (14 years and under) under his or her care at the pool.
8. All children 14 years and under wishing to swim in all areas of the pool must take a swimming test. This test shall be administered by a lifeguard, and can be scheduled during normal pool operating hours. Children who have successfully passed the swimming test shall wear bands and be allowed to swim in all areas of the pool. Children who have not passed the swimming test will not be permitted to swim in the deep end of the pool.
9. If open, the baby pool is not guarded by a lifeguard and any children in the area are the responsibility of, and swim at the risk of, the related adult or responsible minor at the pool.
10. All persons in diapers must wear diapers specially designed for immersion in water (such as swimming diapers). Do not wash out soiled diapers in the pool.
11. There will be a \$500.00 fine plus damages, and the termination of pool membership, levied against anyone defecating or urinating in the pool or otherwise defacing the swimming pool facilities in any way.
12. GUEST PASSES: Each household will be issued one free seasonal guest pass and additional guest passes may be purchased at the KGOSA office at \$10/daily pass. Guests must be accompanied by the resident when using the pool. *There is a limit of four (4) guests per household at any given time.*
13. Please SHOWER before entering the pool every time. This mainly applies to the children playing in the sand.  
PARENTS - WE NEED YOUR COOPERATION.

## **RULES OF CONDUCT**

1. Please drive slowly when entering and leaving the parking lot. The maximum speed is 5 MPH.
2. No glass containers are permitted.
3. Alcoholic beverages are not permitted to be consumed or carried in the pool areas at any time.
4. Entering the pool area while under the influence of alcohol or drugs is prohibited.
5. All food and drink must be kept off the deck area. Please keep any food and drink on the grassy area.
6. Smoking is allowed in the designated smoking area only.
7. Please place all trash and cigarette/cigar butts in the containers provided. Failure to do so may lead to suspension or termination of pool membership.
8. Radios will be permitted only if their operations do not disturb others.

## **HEALTH & SAFETY**

1. All persons use the pool facilities at their own risk. KGOSA will not be responsible for any accident or injury. Any injury must be reported to the pool manager or responsible person in charge immediately.
2. Do NOT enter the pool with: open sores, cuts, skin disorders, bandages, hairpins, chewing gum.
3. Do NOT enter the pool if experiencing diarrhea or stomach issues in the past seven (7) days.
4. Do NOT enter the pool area with any eye, ear, nose or throat infections, or any other known infectious disease. The pool manager can prohibit anyone from use of pool facilities if they exhibit evidence of these.
5. NO FLOATATION AIDS ALLOWED IN THE MAIN POOL.
6. NO DIVING OR JUMPING OFF THE SIDES OF THE POOL.
7. IN THE INTEREST OF SAFETY, NO WRESTLING, NO BALL PLAYING, NO RUNNING, NO PUSHING, NO DUNKING, NO ROUGH PLAY AND NO THROWING ANYONE INTO THE POOL IS ALLOWED.
8. No scuba equipment or swim fins are allowed in the pool. Goggles are permitted.
9. Proper swimming attire must be worn in the pool.
10. No pets are allowed in the pool area.
11. Chairs around the pool must be 4 ft. from the pool's edge. This is for better visibility for the lifeguards and others.

## **RULE ENFORCEMENT PROCESS:**

1<sup>st</sup> Occurrence: Verbal warning issued from pool manager/lifeguard to resident or guest.

2<sup>nd</sup> Occurrence: Pool manager/lifeguard will submit an incident report to KGOSA office. Resident or guest will be asked to leave the pool area for the remainder of the day.

3<sup>rd</sup> Occurrence: Pool manager/lifeguard will complete another incident report and provide to KGOSA office. KGOSA will issue a suspension of pool privileges which may be for a duration of 30 days or longer, to be issued at the Board of Directors' discretion based on the severity of the rule violation.

## **POOL CLOSING PROCEDURES**

All swimmers must be out of the water by 7:50 PM, and everyone must be out of the pool area by 8:00 PM, or as otherwise announced by the pool manager or other person in charge, if the pool facilities are closed earlier.

## **GENERAL**

1. The KGOSA Board of Directors has given complete authority to the pool manager and the lifeguards to enforce all rules and regulations as set forth. Any argument with the pool manager or lifeguards will not be tolerated and may lead to loss of pool privileges. Failure to abide by pool rules and regulations may result in suspension or termination of membership without further notice.
  2. In the interest of orderly procedure and discipline, any appeals on the decision of the pool manager in enforcing the rules or any complaints about employees should be made in writing to the KGOSA office.
- All pool members and users are bound by the Declaration of Kings Grant Open Space Association, Inc., as promulgated per the By-Laws.
